Roll call was taken and all Supervisors were present except Supervisors Polyock, Morrison, and Schaefer who were excused. Supervisor Morrison arrived at 5:07 p.m.

Presentation by Task Force to Optimize Criminal Justice Resources

Supervisor Joyce Ketchpaw began the presentation by introducing the Task Force Committee. She gave the background and the history of the work of the Committee. Supervisor Ketchpaw then turned the presentation over to Mike Schmitz.

Mike Schmitz, Jail Administrator, went over the Report of Findings of the Task Force.

Chief Judge Michael Gibbs then gave an overview of the Recommendations of the Task Force Committee. Gibbs said that a recommendation of the Task Force was to ask the Board to dissolve the Task Force Committee and create a permanent Criminal Justice Coordinating committee, consisting of the same members as the Task Force.

Supervisor Ketchpaw concluded the presentation by thanking the Board.

On motion by Supervisor Morrison, seconded by Supervisor Russell, the Committee of the Whole adjourned at 5:48 p.m.
