

THE MARCH 13, 2007 SESSION
OF THE
WALWORTH COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

The Walworth County Board Committee of the Whole meeting was called to order by Chairperson Lohrmann at 5:00 p.m. in the County Board Room at the Walworth County Government Center, 100 W. Walworth Street, Elkhorn, Wisconsin.

Roll Call

Roll call was conducted and all Supervisors were present except Supervisors Morrison and Schaefer.

- Presentation by the Association for Prevention of Family Violence concerning its services

Sarah Boss, Executive Director, APFV, introduced herself and gave an overview of the services of the Association for the Prevention of Family Violence.

A packet was distributed to the Supervisors. The packet included a list of the APFV Board of Directors, a Service Chart, a Mission Statement and Purpose, a History Outline, a Yearly Comparison of Statistics: Domestic Abuse and Sexual Assault, a graph of Coordinated Community Efforts, and Sources of Federal and State Funding.

Ms. Boss said that APFV is a private, non-profit agency providing direct client services to victims of domestic abuse and sexual assault and their affected family members. She said APFV services range from individual counseling, group counseling, crisis intervention and assisting with restraining orders. APFV works with and in conjunction with law enforcement and judicial partners. Ms. Boss said that APFV does not provide legal advice or counseling services. Ms. Boss said that all APFV services are free of charge.

Ms. Boss gave a history of APFV. She said that APFV began as a task force in 1977 and in 1978 became incorporated as a non-profit agency and began providing services to victims of domestic abuse.

Ms. Boss said that the packet also shows the sources of Federal and State funding for APFV. She said that over a three-year period of time, APFV has brought in \$1,221,483.00 of State and Federal dollars to the County.

Chair Lohrmann then opened the floor for questions. Supervisor Ketchpaw said she wanted to say thank you to one of the most important associations in the County. She said she thinks the services provided by APFV are invaluable. Supervisor Burwell asked what items could be donated to APFV. Ms. Boss said she would submit a list of items needed to Administrator Bretl.

Adjournment

On motion by Supervisor Wagie-Troemel, seconded by Supervisor Ketchpaw, the Committee of the Whole adjourned at 5:25 p.m.
