**Resolution No. 27-09/14**

**Accepting the Kikkoman Corporation Donation of an 11,000 Gallon Storage Tank  
for Public Works Operations**

3 **WHEREAS**, Kikkoman Corporation (Kikkoman) has worked with the Wisconsin Department of  
4 Natural Resources (WDNR) to obtain permission to reuse the waste salt brine liquid (CO water)  
5 from its soy sauce production facility located at N1365 Six Corners Road in Walworth, Wisconsin  
6 as a deicing additive to activate and speed up the effectiveness of and to enhance the adherence of  
7 salt and/or sand applied to highways during cold weather; and,

9 **WHEREAS**, Kikkoman has received a conditional grant of Low Hazard Waste Exemption for  
10 Reuse of Waste Salt Brine as a Road Deicing Additive consistent with the requirements in NR  
11 500.08(5) Wis. Adm. Code, and S289.43(8) WI Stats; and,

13 **WHEREAS**, Kikkoman has offered to donate a 11,000 gallon tank to the Walworth County Public  
14 Works Department to be used to contain the on-site Kikkoman waste salt brine liquid that would be  
15 applied on State and County highways as part of a pilot project to commence with the 2014-2015  
16 winter maintenance season; and,

18 **WHEREAS**, the Walworth County Department of Public Works and Kikkoman are desirous of  
19 participating in this pilot project which could prove to produce significant benefits for both parties.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Walworth County Board of Supervisors does  
22 hereby accept the donation this 11,000 Gallon Storage Tank from Kikkoman as part of a pilot  
23 project to reuse Kikkoman's waste salt brine as a road deicing salt additive.

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Walworth County Board of Supervisors commends  
26 Kikkoman for their generosity and commitment to Walworth County.





**Policy and Fiscal Note**  
**Resolution No. 27-09/14**

- I. Title:** Accepting the Kikkoman Corporation Donation of an 11,000 Gallon Storage Tank for Public Works Operations
- II. Purpose and Policy Impact Statement:** The purpose of this resolution is to accept the donation of an 11,000 Gallon Tank from Kikkoman (approximate value of \$5,000) for the Road Deicing Salt Additive Pilot Project.
- III. Budget and Fiscal Impact:** Acceptance of this donation will allow the county to accept waste salt brine liquid (CO water) for soy sauce production at Kikkoman's Walworth plant.

This will reduce County deicing costs by approximately \$2,600 (salt, water and labor/equipment costs) per winter season. There will be County start-up costs (prep and pumping) of approximately \$2,400 so the return on investment for this project is a little less than one year.






