

MARRIAGE LICENSE APPLICATIONS

Where to Apply: County Clerk's Office, Government Center, Room 101.

Hours: 8:00 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday. Closed Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.

Residents of the state must apply before the County Clerk of the County in which either is a resident. They may be married in any county of the state. One of the applicants must have resided in this county for at least 30 days. Non-residents of the state must be married in the county where the application is made.

Requirements: Documentary proof of identification (State DL or State ID), not expired, with the correct address; Certified copy of Birth Certificates; Copies of judgment of divorce, annulment papers, or death certificates from last previous marriage; Correct spelling of all parents' names; Name, address and phone number of officiant performing the ceremony; Social Security numbers.

Procedure: Apply between 7 and 35 days before ceremony.

Waiting Period: Upon making application, a five-day waiting period is required before license can be issued. This is exclusive of the day of application. The license will be issued on the 6th day and is good for 30 days from date of issuance.

Fee: \$80.00 payable with cash only and an additional \$2 if mailed.

Age: Applicants are of age to marry without parents' consent at 18. Applicants who are 16 and 17 years of age are required to submit both parents' or guardians' consent before issuance of license.

Persons Who May Not Marry: Persons divorced less than 6 months; blood relatives - nearer of kin than second cousin, except when the female is 55 years of age or older; applicants under 16; persons who have been issued a Social Security Number but refuse to provide the number to the County Clerk.
