


SAMPLE OF A SCALED PLOT PLAN



1. Show direction of North.
2. Must be drawn to a scale of 1"=20', 1"=30', 1"= 40', or 1" = 50'
3. Draw all structures, existing and proposed. Label each.
4. Show location of well and septic.
5. Be sure that the setbacks listed on the plot plan are the same as on the application.
6. Setbacks are the distances from the closest point of a structure to lot line.
7. Show all roads that border the parcel.
8. Setback requirements with a scaled plot plan are 1 ½ times the normal requirement that would be allowed with a Plat of survey. EXAMPLE if the normal requirement is 50 feet it would be 75 feet with the scaled plot plan.
9. Show the location of the existing or proposed driveway. This indicates the front of the structure for zoning purposes.
10. This is the minimum information required. IF ANY OF THIS INFORMATION IS MISSING IT MAY CAUSE A DELAY IN THE TIME IT TAKES TO ISSUE YOUR PERMIT.
