➤ Information and Assistance

Provides you with knowledge about services, programs and solutions for disability and long-term care issues

➤ Long-Term Care Options Counseling

Offers information about the choices that are available to meet your long-term care needs

➤ Benefits Counseling

Provides accurate and current information about private and government benefits and programs

➤ Long-Term Care Funding

Determines functional and financial eligibility for the various long-term care funding programs
