This project, which started in early May, is now substantially completed and this will be the last progress report!!

Aside from some minor remaining restoration and landscaping, the last major part of this project to be completed will be the installation of new identification signs for each of the major county buildings on the county government campus as well as a main entrance sign to the campus that will be placed just west of the Sheriff's Office access road. These signs have arrived and will be installed this week.

Special thanks to Patrick Engineering for their work on this project and in particular, Project Manager Kurt Feuerstein and Construction Inspector Patrick Mulligan. Kudos must also go to Highway/Engineering Assistant Cheryl Bahr who also served as a construction inspector on this project. Construction is scheduled to resume on the CTH NN bridge replacements on February 15th (a state DOT project) of next year so there will only be a brief respite from construction for County and Aurora Hospital employees and visitors who use the CTH NN corridor!
