



Lake Beulah Dam Project FINAL Update – August 21, 2015

This is the final project update that you will receive for the Lake Beulah Dam Project!

The lake level continues to stay in the range of the normal pool elevation of 808.00 as dictated by the inspection operation and maintenance plan. The recent rain has increased the level of the lake as expected and it appears from our monitoring that the lake is acting the same after construction as it did before construction. Monitoring of lake levels will become sporadic now that construction is nearly complete and will only be recorded during days we are at the site. After project completion the Lake District will take over the responsibility of monitoring the lake level.


