IF OVERWEIGHT OR OVERWEIGHT AND OVERSIZE: Round weight up to the next ten thousand pound increment.
For example, if weight is 93,000 pounds, round upward to 100,000 weight increment to determine fees.

PROCEDURE TO CALCULATE FEES:

- 1 - Choose the effective and expiration dates you want for the permit for which you are applying.
- 2 - Count up the number of months in the desired permit, from the beginning day to the ending day. When figuring "months," do not use calendar months. The month begins on the effective date of the permit. For example, if you want the permit to become effective May 23, then May 23 to June 22 is counted as exactly 1 month.
- 3 - If the number of months in the desired permit is not exact, round upward to the next whole number of months. For example, if you intend the permit to become effective 5/16/YEAR and to expire 1/21/YEAR, it would be valid for 8 months 6 days. Rounding upward, the desired permit would be subject to the 9 month charge in the fee scale.
