

NOTICE TO PERSON POSTING BOND MONEY

CAUTION: READ INFORMATION ON THIS NOTICE BEFORE POSTING BOND MONEY.

PROVIDE FULL NAME, ADDRESS, ZIP CODE AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF PERSON POSTING MONEY. ANY CHANGE OF ADDRESS FOR THE PERSON POSTING THE MONEY MUST BE SENT IN WRITING TO: Walworth County Circuit Court, P O Box 1001, Elkhorn WI., so any refund can be mailed to the person posting the money.

CONDITIONS FOR POSTING BOND MONEY:

If a judge requires a deposit of cash, the person making the cash deposit shall be given written notice of the requirements of 969.02(6), 969.03(4), and 969.13(5)(a).

1. Sec. 969.02(6) When a judgment of conviction is entered in a prosecution in which a deposit had been made in accordance with sub. (2), the balance of such deposit, after deduction of the bond costs, shall be applied first to the payment of any restitution ordered under s. 973.20 and then if ordered restitution is satisfied in full, to the payment of the judgment.
2. Sec. 969.03(4) If a judgment of conviction is entered in a prosecution in which a deposit had been made in accordance with sub. (1)(d), the balance of the deposit, after deduction of the bond costs shall be applied first to the payment of any restitution ordered under 973.20 and then, if ordered restitution is satisfied in full, to the payment of the judgment.
3. 969.13(5)(a) A cash deposit made with the clerk pursuant to this chapter shall be applied first to the payment of any recompense determined under par. (b) and then, if the recompense is paid in full, to the payment of costs. If any amount of such deposit remains after the payment of costs, it shall be applied to payment of the judgment of forfeiture. The person making the cash deposit shall be given written notice of the requirements of this paragraph.

This means that the bond money you are posting shall be applied to the payment of any restitution, costs and fines ordered on any/all case(s) the cash bond covers. If there is any remaining balance, it will be returned to the person posting the money.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

- Defendant shall appear on all court dates.
- Defendant shall give written notice to the Clerk of this Court, within 48 hours, of any change of address or telephone number.
- Defendant shall not commit any crime.
- Defendant shall neither directly nor indirectly threaten, harass, intimidate or otherwise interfere with victims or witnesses in this action.

This bond money will remain with the court until further court order.
