COVID-19 FROM CRASHING COLLEGE

Off-campus parties and gatherings are one of the main outbreak sources at college campuses in Walworth County



We don't recommend gathering or going to parties at this time
But if we can't convince you otherwise, here's how you can do it more safely and help keep campuses open:



KEEP IT SMALL Keep gatherings to 10 people or less



MASK UP Always wear a mask when attending any party or gathering, including when in the car or using transit/ride shares



STAY OUTSIDE Choose outdoor events, if indoors open doors and windows for ventilation



WASH YOUR HANDS Wash hands frequently with soap and water, and/or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol



HANDS OFF Don't touch your face or your mask when you have it on



BYO Don't share drinks, utensils, tobacco products, etc.



SPACE IT OUT Practice social distancing (6 ft apart from others), including when sitting in chairs and at tables



STAY HOME Don't go out if you aren't feeling well (fever, chills, cough, etc.), or if you or a close contact has tested positive for COVID-19
