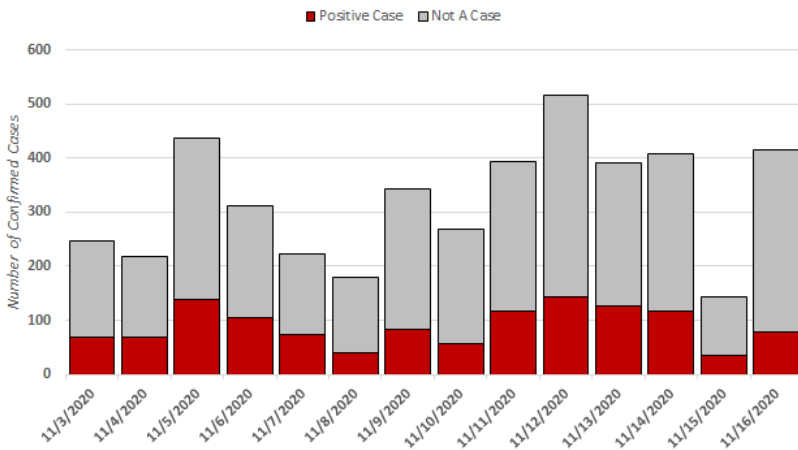


# Walworth County COVID-19 Data Snapshot

Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Day, 11/3-11/16



This graph shows the total number of positive and negative test results for each day between 11/3-11/16.

The average percentage of positive tests over the last 14 days is 27.73%.

## Walworth County Key Indicators

Walworth County Public Health has released new phased guidance for operating safely during COVID-19.

Key Indicators will guide when businesses and organizations should consider moving to the next phase.

Epidemiology	Over the past 14 days: Downward trend of the percentage of total tests that are positive <u>and</u> below an average of 5% of total tests are positive	<b>Green:</b> Below 5% positivity and downward trend <b>Yellow:</b> Only one of these metrics is met less than 5% positivity or downward/flat trend <b>Red:</b> Over 5% positivity and increasing trend	
Hospitals	Over the past 14 days: hospital bed and ventilator capacity is not exceeded	<b>Green:</b> >35% of ICU beds and >50% of ventilators are available <b>Yellow:</b> <35% of ICU beds or <50% of ventilators available <b>Red:</b> <35% of ICU beds and <50% of ventilators available	
	Hospitals have an adequate supply of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): face shields, goggles, N95 masks, surgical masks, and gowns	<b>Green:</b> 15+ day supply of all PPE <b>Yellow:</b> 7-14 day supply of all PPE <b>Red:</b> Less than 7 day supply of all PPE	
Public Health	Positive cases are contacted quickly to help reduce the spread of COVID-19	<b>Green:</b> >75% of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health <b>Yellow:</b> 50-75% of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health <b>Red:</b> <50% or less of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health
