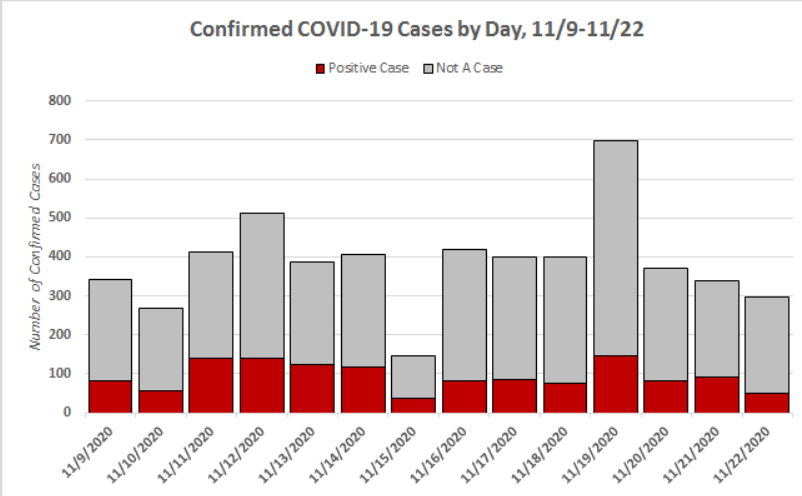


Walworth County COVID-19 Data Snapshot

Walworth County Key Indicators

Walworth County Public Health has released new phased guidance for operating safely during COVID-19.

Key Indicators will guide when businesses and organizations should consider moving to the next phase.

Epidemiology	Over the past 14 days: Downward trend of the percentage of total tests that are positive <u>and</u> below an average of 5% of total tests are positive	Green: Below 5% positivity and downward trend Yellow: Only one of these metrics is met less than 5% positivity or downward/flat trend Red: Over 5% positivity and increasing trend	
Hospitals	Over the past 14 days: hospital bed and ventilator capacity is not exceeded	Green: >35% of ICU beds and >50% of ventilators are available Yellow: <35% of ICU beds or <50% of ventilators available Red: <35% of ICU beds and <50% of ventilators available	
	Hospitals have an adequate supply of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): face shields, goggles, N95 masks, surgical masks, and gowns	Green: 15+ day supply of all PPE Yellow: 7-14 day supply of all PPE Red: Less than 7 day supply of all PPE	
Public Health	Positive cases are contacted quickly to help reduce the spread of COVID-19	Green: >75% of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health Yellow: 50-75% of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health Red: <50% or less of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health
